

PRIVACY AND DATA PROTECTION NOTICE "COP 16 – Biodiversity event"

Suzano is concerned and committed to ensuring your privacy and the protection of your personal data and of all those who have any kind of relationship with us, even if indirectly, thus having the commitment to carry out activities of processing personal information in a responsible way and in compliance with applicable data protection legislation.

As a result, this Notice of Privacy and Data Protection for you, stakeholders interested in joining the event in Cali, Colombia, in Oct 25th, 2024, "Data Subjects", explain our commitment to transparency, so that you can understand in a simple and objective way, what personal information we process, what purposes are involved in our data processing activities and if such information is shared with third parties.

1. What is personal data?

In the context of this Privacy and Data Protection Notice (Notice P&DP), personal data or personal information is defined as any and all information related to the natural person that identifies or makes it possible to identify this person, including sensitive personal data (racial or ethnic origin, religious belief, political opinion, trade union or religious, philosophical or political organization membership, data concerning health or sex life, genetic or biometric data).

2. What personal data will be processed?

The personal information indicated below is limited to the information necessary to fulfill the activities and purposes highlighted in item 03:

- Name
- Phone number
- Email
- Company
- Position

3. What is the purpose of the data processing activities?

Suzano processes the personal information mentioned above for the sole and exclusive purpose of gather data on individuals interested in attending the event in Colombia on Oct 15th and the processing of personal data involves, but is not limited to, the following activities:

- Sending e-mails with Suzano's information, such as sustainability goals, annual report, ESG, awards and others;
- Sending invite for other events: and
- Sending institutional newsletters.

4. Can personal data be shared after its collection?

Considering the activities described above, Suzano may eventually provide or share information, including personal data, with third parties only when necessary for the purpose for which limited access was granted, so no authorization will be extended to access personal information on a personal basis.



You can find below the types of data share involved:

- Between internal areas of Suzano and companies of Suzano Group;
- With service providers and/or suppliers for specific and exclusive purposes of executing a contract with Suzano;
- With judicial, law enforcement or public authorities or other third parties to whom we are obliged by law, any other regulatory rule or court order to share information.

5. How long will my personal data be stored?

Personal information will be retained if necessary to fulfill the data processing activities purposes established above, according to law and regulations, as well as in view of Suzano's internal guidelines.

6. What rights do I have as a Data Subject?

These are your rights:

- To confirm the existence of the processing of personal data;
- To know what they are and have access to the personal data being processed;
- To correct incomplete or outdated personal data;
- To understand the reasons for the data processing activity;
- To revoke consent, if any;
- To be informed about the origin of personal data;
- To be informed about those responsible for the data processing activity;
- In some cases, oppose to certain types of data processing activities;
- In some cases, request the anonymization, blocking or elimination of personal data that may be being treated in an excessive, unnecessary way or in violation of the data protection law.

Before we answer any request mentioned above, we may ask you to provide us with certain information to confirm your identity. We will answer your request after validating your identity.

Requests related to the rights listed above will be evaluated by the Privacy and Personal Data Protection Team with the aim of analyzing the possibility of meeting them. It is important to point out that these rights are not unquestionable, so there is a need for analysis.

7. International Transfer

Your personal data may be transferred to other countries during our processing activities due to the physical and/or digital environments of the solutions involved or due to operations involving international offices of Suzano or third parties. In such cases, we will observe the requirements of the law to ensure that your personal information remains protected, and that such transfer takes place in accordance with the P&DP principles.

8. Updates to this P&DP Notice

Suzano reserves the right to make changes or updates to this Privacy and Data Protection Notice at any discretion and at any time. Whenever the policy changes materially, we will communicate the changes. Thereafter, we consider the amendments to be valid, effective, and binding.
